This funding will be used to

- Improve P-3 Reading achievement as measured by Naplan results (from 89.7% to 97% at NMS) (U2B from 20.5% to 30%) by 2015
- Improve P-3 Writing achievement as measured by Naplan results (from 97% to 99% at NMS) (U2B from 20.5% to 30%) by 2015
- Improve P-3 Numeracy achievement as measured by Naplan results (from 84.6% to 94% at NMS) (U2B from 20.5% to 30%) by 2015

Our strategy will be to

- Continue to embed "Every Day Counts" attendance strategies
- Continue with the Short Term Data Cycles, monitoring and teacher conferencing to:
 - * measure student progress towards reading and number improvement goals
 - * inform coaching for feedback to teachers on effectiveness of pedagogy and to inform future differentiation pedagogy and lesson design
 - * plan new strategies developed from data analysis of individual student performance (Early and Ongoing Intervention, Putting Faces on the Data, Sharratt & Fullan – 14 parameters)
- Fully embed the whole school student feedback process and explicitly link to success criteria (Hattie)
- Develop teachers understanding and capacity to teach "Assessment Literacy" to all students so that student's become assessment literate
- Continue to develop the whole school student goal setting process (Hattie)
- Case Management (Sharratt & Fullan's model) for identified students well below benchmark

Our school will improve student outcomes by

• Purchase HOC to lead curriculum delivery and develop capacity of all staff (top up salary)	\$20 000
• Purchase teacher aide time for targeted small group instruction and oral language programs.	\$25 000
• Provide ongoing professional development on strategies for EAL/D students	\$5 000
• Provide professional development for teachers on pedagogy and differentiation	\$5 000
• Provide professional development for HOC, Master Teacher and STLN on coaching, modelling and co-teaching.	\$5 000
• Provide professional development on data analysis, student feedback and interventions	\$5 000
• Provide TRS for teacher release for professional development and whole school planning	\$12 900
• Purchase Literacy and Numeracy resources to support pedagogy	\$12 060
